Pin Matchbooks/OCC Sewing Kits - 2014

Cut 8 matchbook covers (3"x6") from 1 piece of 12"x12" cardstock OR 6 covers from a 9"x12" sheet of construction paper.


Needed per matchbook:

- 1 Felt piece 23/4" x 23/4"
- 30 Straight pins -1" or longer work best
 - 5 Sewing needles (various sizes; usually come in variety packs of 45 or 60 needles each)
- 4-6 Safety pins (various sizes)

6. Fold top of matchbook down and gently tuck end inside the flap.



5. Place 2-3 staples about 1/4" up from fold (through 3 layers) to hold felt in place.



4. Fold bottom of matchbook up 1"; tuck felt square with pins inside the fold.

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Straight Pins—Worked best to have 3 rows w/ 10 pins per row. Begin w/ row 0, then 0, and then row 0.
- 2.

 Place 5 needles of various sizes above the pins.
- 3.

 Attach <u>safety pins</u> in this area. Hook 5 small-medium safety pins on 1 smaller pin and attach it to the felt from the back. The attached pins will hang on the back side of the felt.

COMPLETED PIN SQUARE:
