SOAP POUCH

Soap pouches are a great addition to any shoebox. These are very simple and inexpensive to make!

Items needed:

Terrycloth or bath towel Sewing machine with thread

- 1. Cut terrycloth in a 4 1/2" x 11" rectangle.
- 2. Finish two shorter edges of rectangle with a zigzag stitch.



3. With right sides together, fold one end of rectangle over 3 ¾". With right sides together, fold the other end on top of the previously folded end so that that the rectangle measures 4 ½" in length.





4. Sew both long sides of rectangle. Turn right side out and insert bar of soap into pouch.





HELPLFUL HINT...A bath towel can be used to make 25+ pouches. Old bath towels work GREAT © Be sure to place these in ziplock bags before putting into your shoebox so that everything does not smell like soap!
