

TAG BLANKET

This is a wonderful item for any of the boxes for the 2 - 4 year old children. Boys and girls can cuddle up with this little blanket and rub their fingers on the soft satin ribbon.

Items needed:

- 2 squares of fabric --12" x 12" (fabrics should be flannel or fleece)
- 12 pieces of ribbon -- 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ " each (use a variety of **SATIN** ribbon $\frac{3}{4}$ - 1" wide)
- Sewing machine with thread

Instructions:

1. Fold ribbons in half, wrong sides together. Sew three pieces of ribbon to each of the four edges of one piece of fleece. Be sure to sew the ribbons to the right side of the fabric. Stitch using $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. (When sewing on the ribbon, have the folded edge of the ribbon face toward the center of the blanket.)



2. Place the back of blanket on top of the front. Make sure that the right sides are together and the ribbons are pointing toward the center of the fabric. Sew around the edge of the blanket using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Leave an opening for turning.



3. Turn blanket so the right sides are out. The ribbons should now point outward. See photo below. (The blanket is folded over to show both the front and back of it.)



4. Topstitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " from edge of blanket on outside. This will close the opening that was used for turning.
