## JOINING THE SECRET CLUB

#### PHILIPPIANS 4:10-13

Philippians 4:10-13 I rejoiced in the Lord greatly that once again you renewed your care for me. You were, in fact, concerned about me but lacked the opportunity to show it. I don't say this out of need, for I have learned to be content in whatever circumstances I am.

I know both how to have a little, and I know how to have a lot. In any and all circumstances I have learned the secret of being content—whether well fed or hungry, whether in abundance or in need. I am able to do all things through Him who strengthens me.

# In verse 11, Paul uses the word content to describe his life.

Content refers to the idea of being satisfied with what you have, no matter how small. 1 Timothy 6:6 But godliness with contentment is a great gain.

### We live in a world full of discontented people.

# We are told to never be satisfied.

# Rather than be content, we live lives of complaining.

- people -homes -cars -jobs -church and pastor "Contentment makes poor men rich; discontentment makes rich men poor."

#### -Ben Franklin

In these verses Paul shares with us the secrets to being satisfied.

### 1. REJOICE IN YOUR SUBSTANCE

Philippians 4:10, 12 I rejoiced in the Lord greatly that once again you renewed your care for me. You were, in fact, concerned about me but lacked the opportunity to show it. I know both how to have a little, and I know how to have a lot. In any and all circumstances I have learned the secret of being content -whether well fed or hungry, whether in abundance or in need.

1 Timothy 6:7-8 For we brought nothing into the world, and we can take nothing out. But if we have food and clothing, we will be content with these.

# Are you satisfied with what you have?

### Do you believe that God will supply what you need?

#### Remember two things

#### 1. God knows your needs.

#### A. He may provide it Himself (like manna from Heaven) I Kings 17

#### B. He may use other people Galatians 6

Galatians 6:10 Therefore, as we have opportunity, we must work for the good of all, especially for those who belong to the household of faith.

2. No matter what He provides, rejoice.

Hebrews 13:5 Your life should be free from the love of money. Be satisfied with what you have, for He Himself has said, I will never leave you or forsake you.

### 2. REST IN YOUR SITUATION

Philippians 4:11 I don't say this out of need, for I have learned to be content in whatever circumstances am.

Think about who is writing this letter. Paul has learned this from jail, shipwreck, during bearings, etc.

### What doors will God open in your current situation?

Not all of our circumstances are for immediate life. Maybe God is using this to prepare you for your testimony.

### 3. REALIZE YOUR STRENGTH

Philippians 4:13 I am able to do all things through Him who strengthens me.

# Paul does not choose to say "I can't".

# He chooses not to be pessimistic.

At the same time it is not the power of positive thinking.

# Paul also does not choose to say"l can".

# He chooses not to be presumptuous.

He has an understanding that in and of himself he is nothing. He does not have the power to make everything happen.

Instead he understands that he can overcome anything with the power of God.

### Are you choosing to tap into the power source?

### Are you content?
