THANKFUL FOR THE SAVIOR

HEBREWS 13:5-8

Hebrews 13:5 Your life should be free from the love of money. Be satisfied with what you have, for He Himself has said, I will never leave you or forsake you.

Hebrews 13:6 Therefore, we may boldly say: The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?

Hebrews 13:7 Remember your leaders who have spoken God's word to you. As you carefully observe the outcome of their lives, imitate their faith.

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

1 Thessalonians 5:18 Give thanks in everything, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

3 REASONS TO BE THANKFUL FOR THE SAVIOR

1. He is an "abiding" Savior

Hebrews 13:5 Your life should be free from the love of money. Be satisfied with what you have, for He Himself has said, I will never leave you or forsake you.

No matter where life takes you as a follower of Christ, you will never do it alone.

Matthew 28:20 teaching them to observe everything l have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

Isaiah 41:10 Do not fear, for I am with you; do not be afraid, for I am your God. I will strengthen you; I will help you; I will hold on to you with My righteous right hand.

John 15:4 Remain in Me, and I in you. Just as a branch is unable to produce fruit by itself unless it remains on the vine, so neither can you unless you remain in Me.

2. He is an "assisting" Savior

Hebrews 13:6 Therefore, we may boldly say: The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?

Psalm 46:1 God is our refuge and strength, a helper who is always found in times of trouble.

The word "helper" comes from a word meaning "to run to".

It implies that the Lord is running to our aid.

John 14:15-16 "If you love Me, you will keep My commands. And I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Counselor to be with you forever.

He is our

-Counselor -Comforter -Aid

Let me caution you though!

God is NOT your co-pilot.

We rely on Him. We trust in Hum. We cling to Him.

Not the other way around.

3. He is an "anchoring" Savior

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

One of the greatest reasons you and I can be thankful, is because He is a never-changing God.

This is why He can make the statement

Psalm 46:1 God is our refuge and strength, a helper who is always found in times of trouble.

Matthew 28:18 Then Jesus came near and said to them, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.

Proverbs 3:5-6 Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not rely on your own understanding; think about Him in all your ways, and He will guide you on the right paths.
