**3 REASONS TO BE
THANKFUL FOR THE
SAVIOR**

**1. He is an “abiding”
Savior**

Hebrews 13:5 Your life should be free from the love of money. Be satisfied with what you have, for He Himself has said, I will never leave you or forsake you.

**No matter where life
takes you as a follower
of Christ, you will never
do it alone.**

Matthew 28:20
teaching them to
observe everything I
have commanded you.
And remember, I am
with you always, to the
end of the age.”

**Isaiah 41:10 Do not fear,
for I am with you; do not
be afraid, for I am your
God. I will strengthen
you; I will help you; I will
hold on to you with My
righteous right hand.**

**John 15:4 Remain in Me,
and I in you. Just as a
branch is unable to
produce fruit by itself
unless it remains on the
vine, so neither can you
unless you remain in Me.**

**2. He is an “assisting”
Savior**

Hebrews 13:6

**Therefore, we may
boldly say: The Lord is
my helper; I will not be
afraid. What can man
do to me?**

**Psalm 46:1 God is our
refuge and strength, a
helper who is always
found in times of
trouble.**

The word “helper”
comes from a word
meaning “to run to”.

It implies that the Lord
is running to our aid.

**John 14:15-16 “If you
love Me, you will keep
My commands. And I
will ask the Father, and
He will give you
another Counselor to
be with you forever.**

He is our

-Counselor

-Comforter

-Aid

**Let me caution you
though!**

**God is
NOT
your co-pilot.**

**We rely on Him.
We trust in Him.
We cling to Him.**

**Not the other way
around.**

**3. He is an “anchoring”
Savior**

**Hebrews 13:8 Jesus
Christ is the same
yesterday, today, and
forever.**

One of the greatest reasons you and I can be thankful, is because He is a never-changing God.

**This is why He can
make the statement**

I AM !

**Psalm 46:1 God is our
refuge and strength, a
helper who is always
found in times of
trouble.**

**Matthew 28:18 Then
Jesus came near and
said to them, “All

given to Me in heaven
and on earth.**

**Proverbs 3:5-6 Trust in
the Lord with all your
heart, and do not rely on
your own understanding;
think about Him in all
your ways, and He will
guide you on the right
paths.**
