# The New Testament focuses on a couple different usages for the word.

#### 1. Friendliness

-it fosters relationships
-it is not in a vaccuum

1 Corinthians 13:4-5 Love is patient, love is kind. Love does not envy, is not boastful, is not conceited, does not act improperly, is not selfish, is not provoked, and does not keep a record of wrongs.

We see the picture of worrying about someone else and not ourselves. We are also the beneficiaries of the kindness of God.

**Ephesians 2:6-7 Together** with Christ Jesus He also raised us up and seated us in the heavens, so that in the coming ages He might display the immeasurable riches of His grace through His kindness to us in Christ Jesus.
