1 Corinthians 10:12 So, whoever thinks he stands must be careful not to fall.

1 Corinthians 10:13 No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to humanity. God is faithful, and He will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation He will also provide a way of escape so that you are able to bear it.

1 Corinthians 10:14 Therefore, my dear friends, flee from idolatry.

Salvation is not a fool proof barrier for temptation.

If anything, it puts a bigger target on your back.

When it comes to temptation there are two ways in which we respond.

1. We give in

2. We overcome

I do believe that each of us have one area where we are more apt to fall.

Hebrews 12:1 Therefore, since we also have such a large cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let us lay aside every weight and the sin that so easily ensnares us.

The concern we should have is in thinking that we have arrived at a place where we are above giving in and sinning.

1 Corinthians 10:12 So, whoever thinks he stands must be careful not to fall.

Proverbs 16:18 Pride comes before destruction, and an arrogant spirit before a fall

So why doesn't God just take away all temptation?

If there were no temptation to sin, then we would have no need to be overcomers.

Without a battle, there is no victory in 'Jesus.

We also need to express our dependence on Him.

2. Where does temptation come from?

Understand that temptation is "common" to man.

1 Corinthians 10:13 No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to humanity. God is faithful, and He will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation He will also provide a way of escape so that you are able to bear it.

There are three areas where temptation comes from.

1 John 2:16 For everything that belongs to the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride in one's lifestyle—is not from the Father, but is from the world.

A. Flesh

You and I inherited a sin nature from Adam. We are born with a bent toward sin.

We continue through life with a choice to make. How will we walk?

Galatians 5:16 I say then, walk by the Spirit and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh.

Galatians 5:17 For the flesh desires what is against the Spirit, and the Spirit desires what is against the flesh; these are opposed to each other, so that you don't do what you want.

B. World

James 4:4 Adulteresses! Don't you know that friendship with the world is hostility toward God? So whoever wants to be the world's friend becomes God's enemy.

Is it possible for a believer to become so worldly that they fail to stand out for the Lord?

How do you and I keep from getting there?

Romans 12:1 Therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, Lurge you to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God; this is your spiritual worship.

Romans 12:2 Do not be conformed to this age, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may discern what is the good, pleasing, and perfect will of God.

C. Devil

The devils goal is to see you fail and fall.

1. So God is dishonored

2. So you are useless to the Kingdom

3. How do we defeat temptation?

A. Flight

B. Faith

A. Flight

1 Corinthians 6:18 Run from sexual immorality!

Ex. Joseph

1 Corinthians 10:14 Therefore, my dear friends, flee from idolatry.

2 Timothy 2:22 Flee from youthful passions, and pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace, along with those who call on the Lord from a pure heart.

Proverbs 6:27-28 Can a man embrace fire and his clothes not be burned? Can a man walk on burning coals without scorching his feet?

B. Faith

We need faith that in giving up the world, God will be all we need.

1 John 5:3 For this is what love for God is: to keep His commands. Now His commands are not a burden,

1 John 5:4 because whatever has been born of God conquers the world. This is the victory that has conquered the world: our faith.

"Faith is the victory that overcomes the world."

C. Fight

James 4:7 Therefore, submit to God. But resist the Devil, and he will flee from you.

1 Peter 5:8 Be serious! Be alert! Your adversary the Devil is prowling around like a roaring lion, looking for anyone he can devour.

Remember that the devil does not fear you, but he is terrified and defeated by the blood of Jesus.

This helps us to remember who the fight belongs to.

We defeat temptation through the power of the Holy Spirit.
